EPIPHANY 2026 – Chalking of the Doors. In various parts of the world, the Epiphany is marked with the time-honoured tradition of “chalking the doors.” The formula for the ritual is simple: take chalk of any colour and write above the entrance of your home: **20 + C + M + B + 26**.

The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Magi — Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar - who came to visit Jesus in the place where he was born. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, Christus Mansionem Benedic: “May Christ bless the house.” The “+” signs represent the cross, and the “20” at the beginning and the “26” at the end mark the year. Taken together, this inscription is performed as a request for Christ to bless the building so marked and that He stay with those who dwell or work therein throughout the entire year.

Prayer for the Week: Loving Father, bless our family and those we hope to welcome over the course of this year. May we be blessed with health, goodness of heart, gentleness, and abiding in your will. We ask this through Christ our Lord who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.
