

Sunday of the Word of God -25 January 2026



The Catholic Church will celebrate the Seventh Sunday of the Word of God on Sunday, 25 January 2026, under the motto: “*The word of Christ dwells among you*” (Col 3:16). Observed each year on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, this day invites the faithful to reflect on, celebrate, and share the Word of God in their daily lives.

The celebration was established by Pope Francis in his 2019 Apostolic Letter *Aperuit illis*, emphasizing the essential connection between the Risen Lord, Christian communities, and Sacred Scripture. The Pope calls on all believers to make the Word of God a living presence in their hearts, guiding their actions and inspiring their witness.

“Saint Paul’s words to the Colossians, ‘The word of Christ dwells among you’, invite us not only to listen to the Word but to let it dwell within us. The Word shapes our thoughts, guides our desires, and unites the Christian community. To welcome it is to allow Christ to speak through our lives, bringing hope and life to those around us.”
